A register audit and review of pupil attendance was undertaken at the beginning of the month. School attendance is in line with the National Expectation of 96%. If you have any concerns about a child, please speak to the staff at school. They will direct you to the DESIGNATED SAFEGUARDING LEADS – who are Ingrid Rounce and Rachel Quick. However, all staff and volunteers receive regular training and updates. Our Safeguarding Governor is Daniel Forde-Pogson.

Safeguarding concerns are dealt with extremely seriously and carefully and sometimes we may need to take advice from the teams at the Safeguarding Hub (known as MASH).
