Dear Parents/Carers,

Tomorrow, THURSDAY 11th FEBRUARY we will be having some work done on the trees on school site. Sadly we will be losing one of the oaks at the front of the school as it is quite diseased and has quite a tilt now and poses a risk in terms of its potential to fall. We have been told by Great Yarmouth District Council that it is not a protected oak tree, so the decision to remove the crown and take it to a lower height has been taken. We will also have work done on another damaged oak tree at the front of the school and possibly (time and weather permitting) some further work on one of the horse chestnuts on the playground.

How will this affect the school?

We will be open as normal, tree work will not affect the learning in school. Staff will however, park on the playground and at the far end of the car-park well away from the tree work. The car-park will not be open after 8.15am on safety grounds. We anticipate that the work will be finished close to the end of the school day, but please do not use the car park or access school through the car park or road gates on this day. For added security we will continue to lock the gate to the field once the children are in class.
