Welcome Back!

We hope you have enjoyed the summer break and are now ready to come to school prepared for the fun and challenges that lay ahead. We welcome 9 new children into Reception, all girls this year! We also welcome Mrs Nicolene Clutten and Mrs Tina Cogdell into school. Mrs Clutten will be working in Emerald Class and Mrs Cogdell will be in the school office on a Monday and Friday.

Curriculum:

Each class will be sending home a "curriculum newsletter" for their class, which will tell you more about the learning taking place in all the subject area. It will include information, such as when PE sessions are, any planned visits, suggestions for how you may wish to support your child's learning in topic areas, as well as homework details. Attendance:

We are lucky to be surrounded by excellent staff, who work incredibly hard to build an exciting curriculum for children to immerse themselves within and make terrific strides in their learning. To make sure that learning opportunities are taken advantage of, children need excellent attendance in school. We would love every child to attend 100% of the time, but children can be unwell at times, or there are times within any family, such as illness or bereavement which mean that children are unable to come to school. Please let us know if we can help in any of these situations.

Absence after illness – if your child is sick due to a sickness "bug" we would ask you to keep your child off school for at least 24 hours; if your child is sick for any other reason, eg coughing too much, please speak to office staff for about If your child needs some simple medical support, such as Calpol, or if anti-biotics are needed we can support this – please ask in the office for a permission form.

Music Lessons:

The Rock & Pop foundation are now offering guitar and keyboard lessons at school. Students get a chance to develop skills across a range of playing styles with all genres and disciplines, including classical. Working from the fully accredited syllabus enables students to not only learn skills on a specific instrument but also in music theory and performance skills. They will also get the opportunity to take an exam in their chosen instruments with ABRSM, Trinity Guildhall and Rockschool. ``

Lessons are available for students from Year 3 upwards, either in groups or on a one-to-one basis. Group guitar lessons are £7.90, while keyboard lessons are £8.30 per week. For more information please pick up an enrolment form from the school office or visit www.rockandpopfoundation.com.

EYFS Profile

Parents of Reception children are invited into school to have a look at their child's Early Years Foundation Stage Profile. The EYFS profile is a summary of your child's attainment. It's not a test, and your child can't 'pass' or 'fail'. The profile measures your child's attainment in 17 areas of learning, known as Early Learning Goals (ELGs). The profiles will be available for you to have a look at 2.45pm on Tuesday 17th October and Friday 8th December.

Staff Carpark

The carpark at the front of school is strictly for staff and visitors only. When dropping off and picking up your children please use the carpark at the Village Hall. The only exception to this is for disabled badge holders.

Playground Equipment
