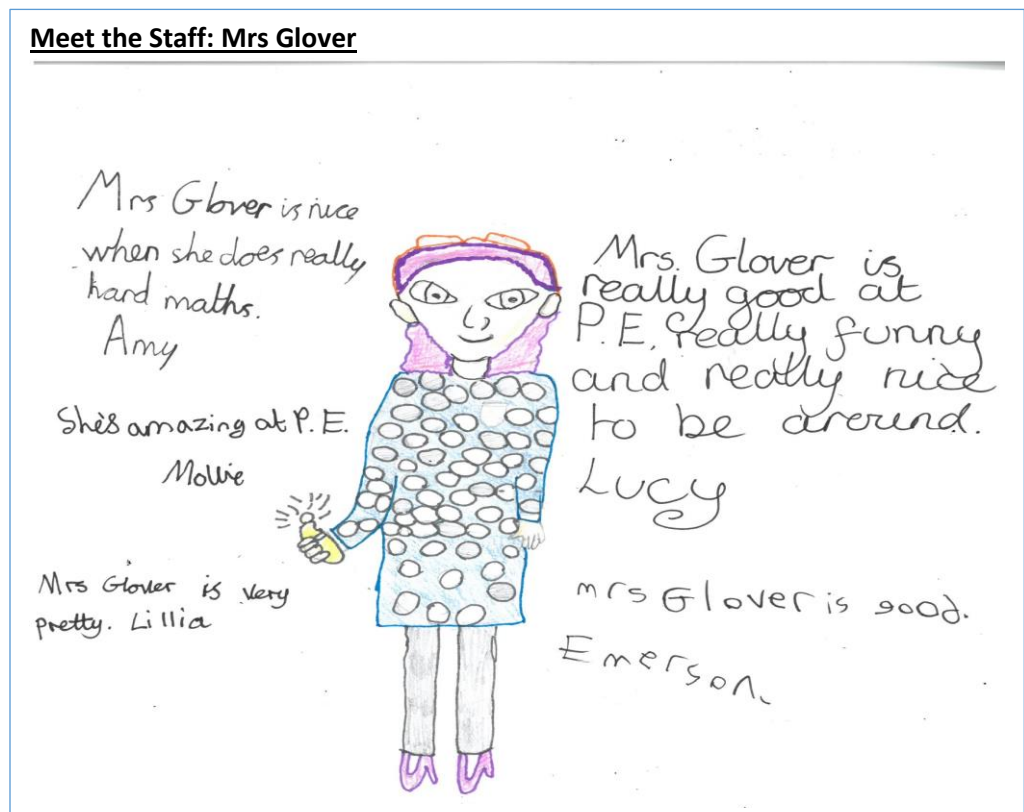

Homework Project:

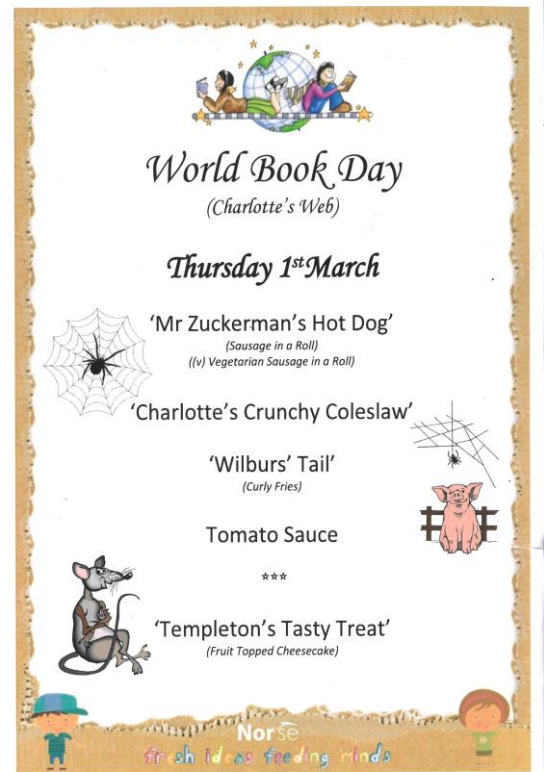
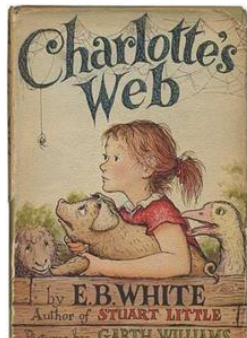
