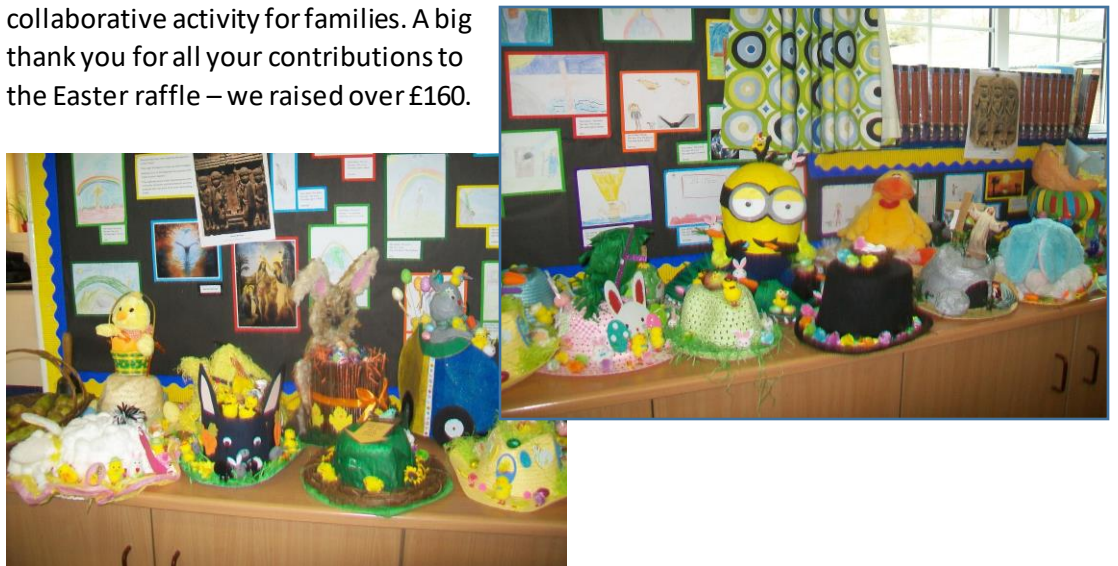
Key Stage 1 Football tournament:
