### Sports Day:

They will also need to have a water bottle, a hat and sun-cream as they will be outside.

### Cromer Trip:

Our whole school trip to Cromer will take place on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> July. We will be travelling via coach to Cromer and the children will need to bring a packed lunch with them. If you would like to order a school packed lunch please let the office know in advance – the kitchen will be unable to make a packed lunch on the day, unless it has been booked on or before Monday 16<sup>th</sup> July.

The children will need to wear school uniform for the trip and must bring enough to drink with them. We will leave school as soon as the children have been registered so please ensure that they arrive promptly. A further letter will follow next week with more details and a permission slip attached which will need to be completed and returned to school.

### Transition sessions:

On Monday 9<sup>th</sup> July we will be holding our transition sessions for our current Reception and Y1-5 pupils. The children will spend time with the teacher they will have from September. We will be having 2 classes: Emerald Class (Reception, Y1 & 2) will be taught by Mrs Swinson and Mrs Yassin, and Diamond Class (Year 3, 4, 5 & 6) will be taught by Mrs Rounce.

Year 6 pupils going to Flegg High and Acle Academy will be spending Monday 9<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> at their new schools. They will be travelling by bus from school.
